

Dr. Henry Daniell pioneered the chloroplast genetic engineering technology. His publications have been often featured on the cover of premier journals, including Nature Biotechnology and widely cited by peers. His research is currently funded by major agencies for \$3.2 million (NIH, DOE, USDA). A biotech company (Chlorogen Inc.) has been created based on Henry's patents and this has attracted large investments. Henry has received several awards and his research has been often highlighted in scientific journals (Nature & Science) and the popular press, including New York Times, Scientific American and featured by several TV broadcasting stations (CNN, BBC, CBS, NBC, ABC). Henry serves as a consultant to the United Nations on biotechnology.
